



Owen Roe is devoted to producing the most intense wines possible from great vineyards in the Pacific Northwest. Grapes are sourced from excellent vineyards in the Willamette, Mid-Columbia, Yakima Valley, and Walla Walla Valleys. Each vineyard is contracted by the acre with strict controls on yields and vine development. The protocol in winery follows similarly tight controls- minimal handling, racking by gravity, and excellent cooperage greeting the fruit. Owen Roe produces some 4,500 cases of single vineyard and blended wines.

<b>2005 Abbott's Table</b> Abbot's Table is inspired by what the English call Claret More than half of the blend of Abbot's Table is the Bordeaux varieties of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc - it's the non-traditional Zinfandel, Pinot Noir, Grenache, and Syrah that make this wine so drinkable.	\$19.99	\$29.99	_____	
<b>2005 Sinister Hand</b> Every year, this wine is an exuberant, lush, lively, juicy blend of Rhone varieties. This year it's 52% Grenache, 39% Syrah, 7% Mourvedre, and 2% Counoise, all from Elerding Vineyard in Washington.	\$19.99	\$29.99	_____	
<b>2005 Ex Umbris Syrah</b> This Syrah is named for the personal motto of Cardinal John Henry Newman "Ex umbris et imaginibus in veritatem"(From shadows and symbols goes the truth). <b>2005 Sharecropper's Pinot Noir</b> This beautifully maintained vineyard (Kevin Chambers is vineyard manager) produces Pinot noir on Willakenzie soil, growing the 114, 115, and 777 clones. The wine is spicy and charmingly well balanced- not a huge wine, but a melange of red fruits, hints of cedar, cinnamon, clove, white pepper, and a long, very refreshing finish.	\$19.99	\$29.99	_____
