Price: \$9.99.

Varietal: 100 percent barbera.

Where it's from: California.

Style: This rose has a huge aroma of strawberries, followed by a flavor of sweet strawberries and a creamy, slightly spicy finish.

Pairings: Pair this with grilled chicken, salmon and pork chops.

Why it's a buy: This lush wine is a pleasure, especially for those partial to strawberries. It is reasonably priced, pairs well with food and is extremely refreshing. Can't say much more for a wine under \$10.
